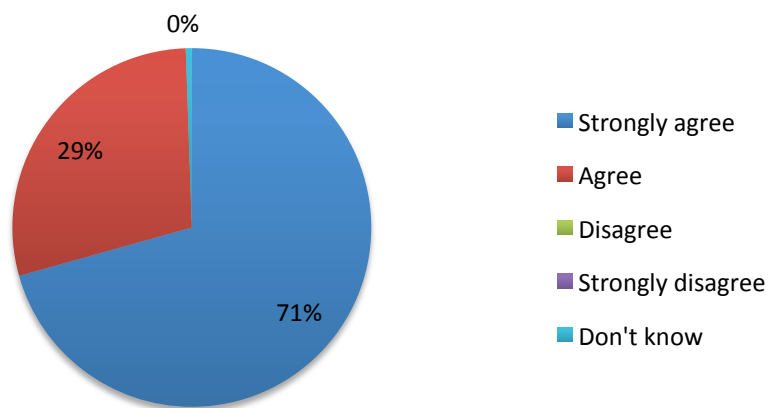
The teaching at Tidemill is good



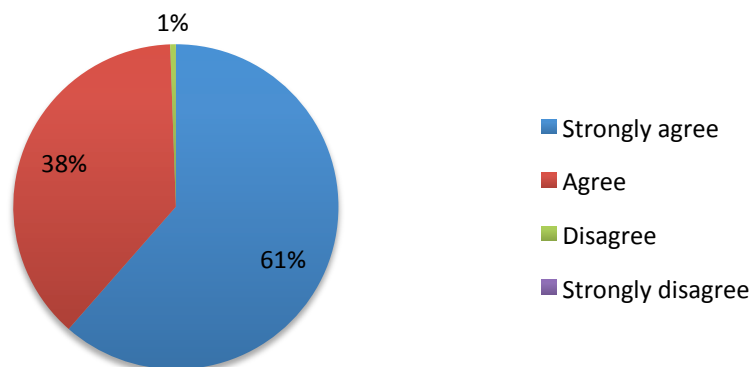

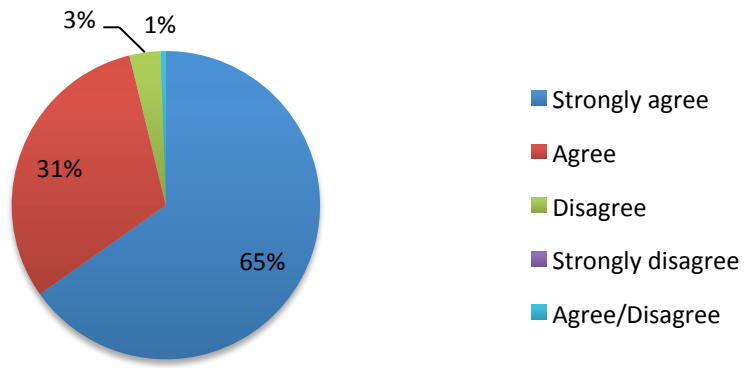
Tidemill is a creative school



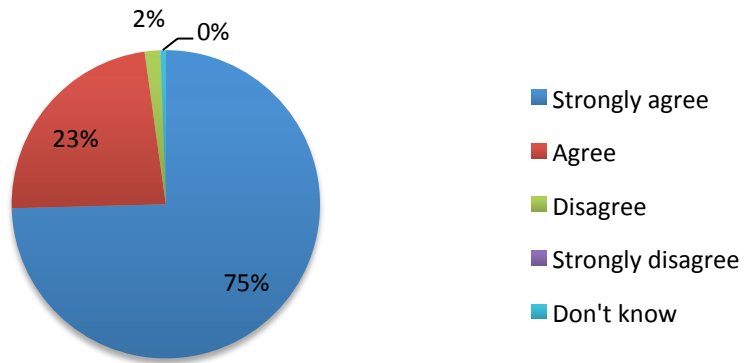

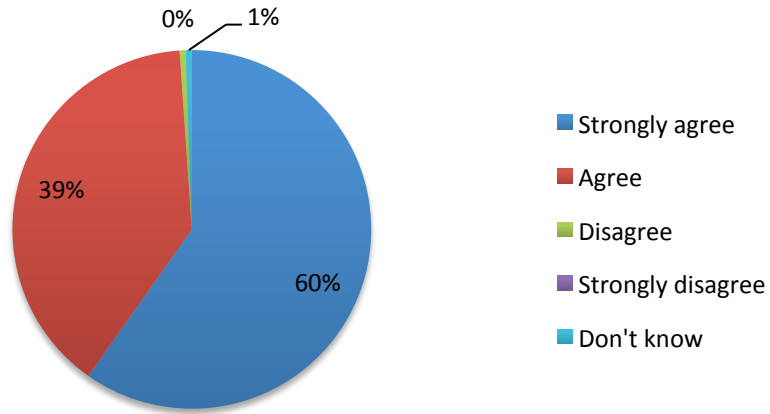

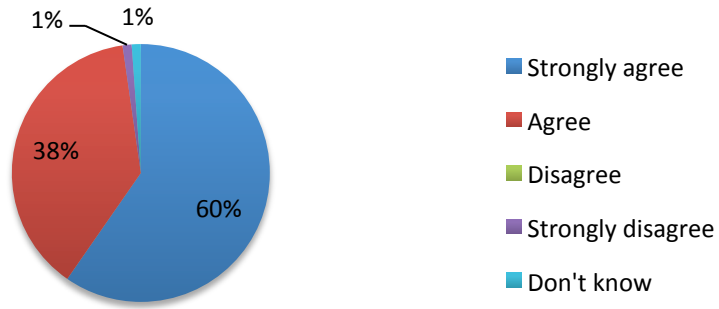

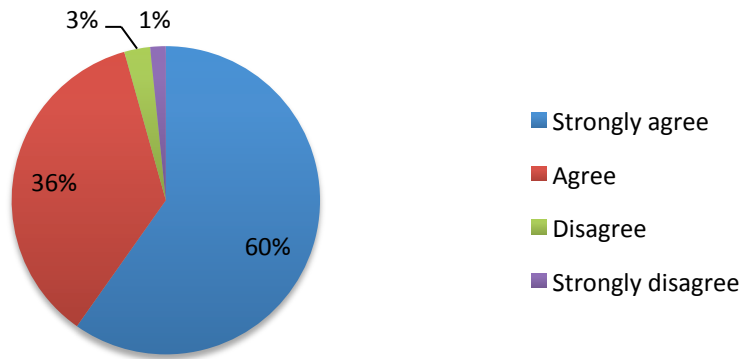
Tidemill has a fair behaviour policy that rewards good behaviour



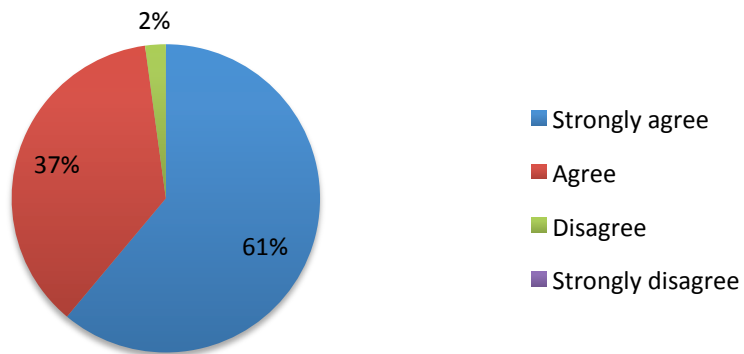
Tidemill has a behaviour policy that provides clear sanctions for inappropriate behaviour



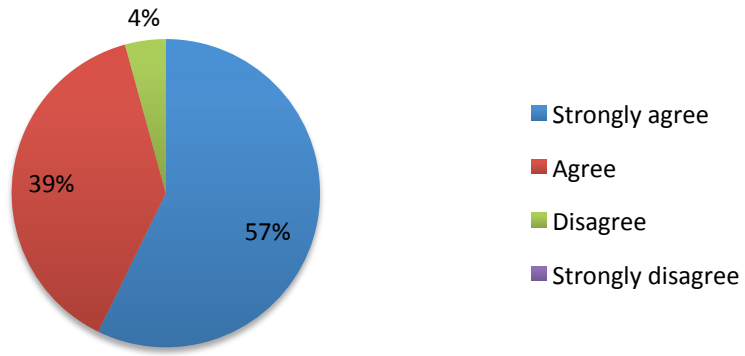

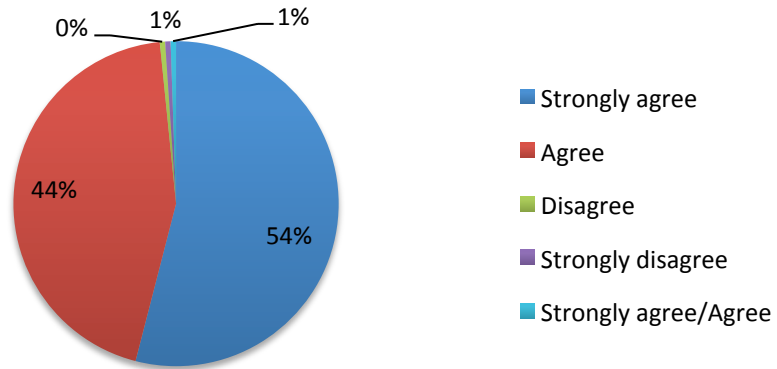
I am kept well informed about events and extra-curricular activities



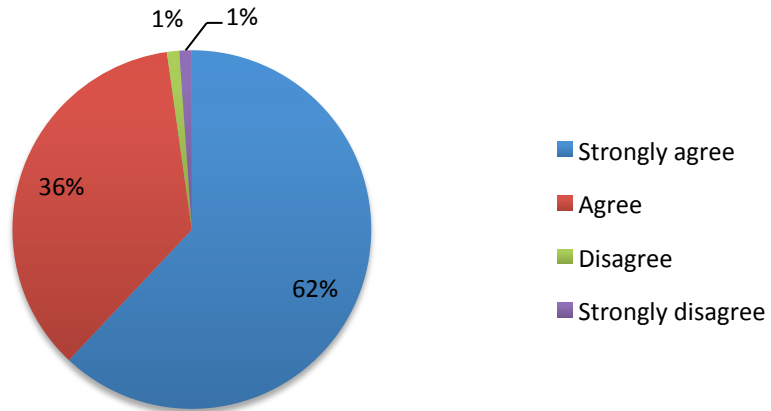
I know how to help my child with their learning at home



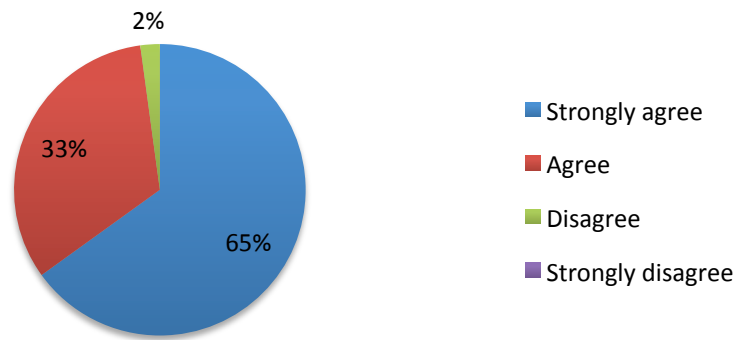
I am able to read regularly with my child at home and feel comfortable supporting them



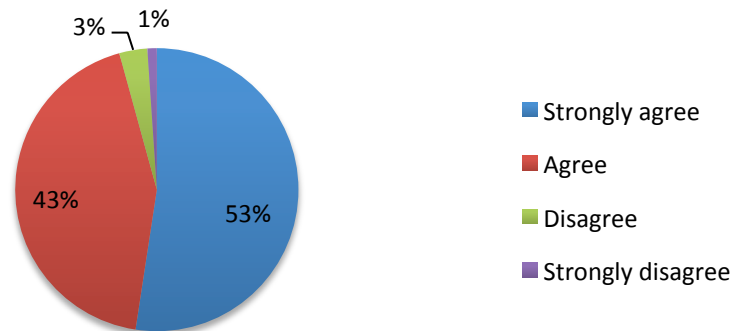
The school is led and managed well



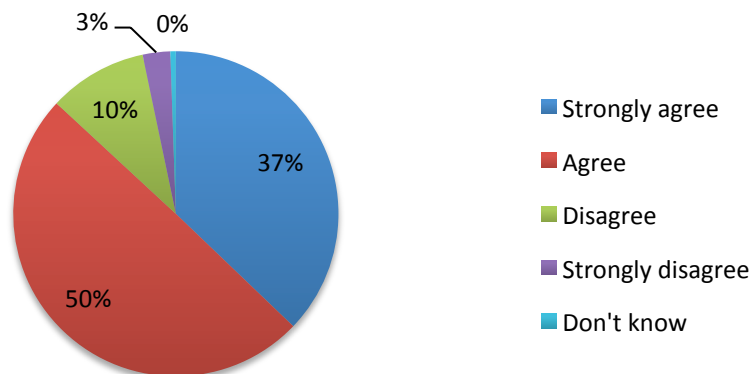
I am kept well informed about what is happening in the school through newsletters, tweets, texts and displays



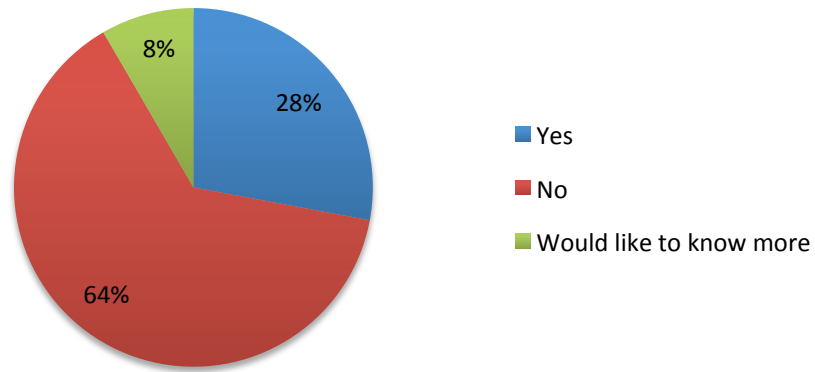
There are regular opportunities for parents to get involved in the life of the school and attend events



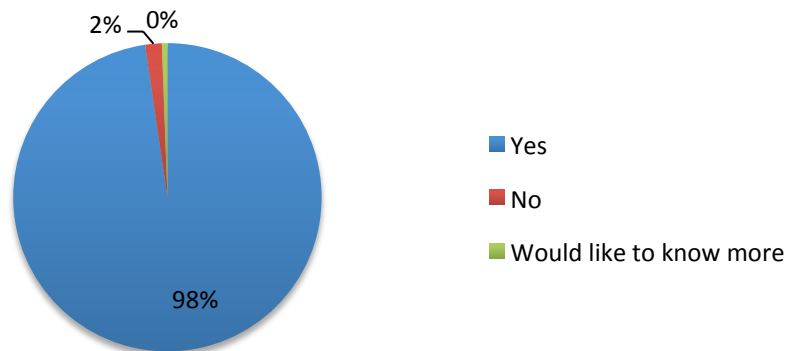
